An everyday stroller that also travels well	UPPAbaby Minu V2 — a genuinely more comfortable ride, at a larger folded size
The smallest possible folded size, above all else	gb Pockit+ — less than half the size of most lightweight strollers
Seat comfort over travel compactness	Chicco Liteway — a roomy seat with a deep recline
Mostly driving, occasionally flying, on a budget	Summer Infant 3Dlite — the honest budget pick
